



Call for PhD Courses

Funds Available for New Climate Courses

Developing a PhD course is a great way of supporting graduate students as it can be tailored to their exact need. It is also an excellent opportunity to invite guest scientists, for the purpose of collaborative teaching and, of course, collaborative research.

The Bolin Centre Climate Research School offers funds for development, modification and delivery of courses with a focus on climate and Earth System studies. These courses should be aimed mainly at PhD students but may also be open to masters students.

How to Apply

If you are interested in developing a course, please submit a proposal to the Bolin Centre for Climate Research.

Criteria for evaluation and approval of the proposal:

- The course strengthens research training in climate science at Stockholm University and its partners within the Bolin Centre for Climate Research
- The instructors are accomplished teachers, researchers or technologists
- External guest lectures are desirable but not required
- Courses that involve more than one department or partner of the Bolin Centre are favoured
- The lead applicant is a member of the Bolin Centre for Climate Research

3. Proposed Dates for Course Delivery
4. Course Implementation Team (specify one lead person)
5. Short Summary (200 words)
6. New course or modification of an existing course?
7. Masters students eligible or PhD students only?
8. Budget
 - i. Approximate estimate of the total number of hours for course development
 - ii. Approximate estimate of the total number of hours for course delivery
 - iii. Estimated costs for bringing external teachers to Stockholm (e.g. flights, accommodation, honorarium/salary)
 - iv. Estimated costs for consumables etc. needed for course development
