Report from the chairman

Kess reports on current activities and issues relecant to the PhD students in the department:

- Regarding the ethics seminar, the old seminar is from 2018 replaced by a part of a mandatory introductory course. The next ethics module of this course is planned for March 20-21, 2018. The introductory course will amount to 5 hp. Apart from the ethics module the content of the course will involve for example general information about doing a PhD at Fysikum, important rules and a workshop on academic writing.
- There will also be a mandatory broadening course with the purpose of ensuring a broad knowledge within the subject of the PhD.
- The issue of the salary raise at 50% of the PhD and the connection to the licentiate is currently not a priority and will not be until the the new ethics part and the broadening course are handled.
- Regarding the ISP:s, Per-Erik wants to remind all supervisors and PhD students to make sure that ISP:s are handed in on time.
- The PhD council website is currently down and will not be reinstated in the same form. Emma is working on a Mondo site that we will later have to replace when Mondo is phased out.
- Kess is planning to organise a workshop held by FeelGood regarding stress in January next year, at Fysikum.
