6 Report from the chairman

Ethics course

The ethics course has been given in the spring. No concerns about the course were raised.

Broad course

The colloquium course is ongoing and is mandatory for new PhD students in physics and theoretical physics. No concerns about the course were raised.

50 % salary raise and the licentiate

The salary raise for PhD student is now given after 50 % of the time spent towards the PhD, rather than after the completion of the licentiate degree. This is a temporary rule that will be subject to change once the head of the department (prefekt) and the PhD students responsible brings a new proposal to be analyzed and put into place in junction with the PhD council.

PhD council website

The PhD council website can now be found on the Fysikum website. It contains information about the PhD council as well as general useful information about PhD studies. Feedback is expected from the PhD students so that the website/information can be improved.

ISP

Within the next year, the ISP will be changed, from a PDF-file that you fill in and submit to the head of the department, to an integrated online system which include automatic reminders and other useful features. Suggestions of features to implement in this new system can be sent to Pil Saugmann.

Evaluation of PhD programs

The Swedish government is evaluating the PhD programs and one of the physics programs was selected as a test case. The goal of this evaluation is quality assurance.
