



Extra days to your PhD employment paid by the department / faculty

Typically: 1 meeting = 1 day of prolongation

 \rightarrow No research time is "lost" :)

Prolongation system

PhD council board:

- Chair: (15) days (fixed)
- Vice-chair: (10) days (fixed)
- Regular representative: (2+1*#) days, where # is the number of board meetings.

Committees at Fysikum:

- Fysikum Styrelse: (2+1*#) days, where # is the number of committee meetings.
- All the other committees: (1+1/2*#) days, where # is the number of committee meetings.
- Secondary representatives: (1*#) days, only for the attended meetings.

Specific tasks (e.g. applications evaluations): it should be agreed with the senior requesting participation from PhD students.
